- ☺ This week-long, day camp for kids entering 2nd through 6th grades has been a Wallowa County tradition for over 40 years.
- ☺ Located at Buhler Ranch, a private residence on Ski Run Road 2 miles south of Joseph, the camp features an outdoor amphitheater and log lodge complete with restrooms and kitchen.
- ☺ We work hard to keep fees low despite rising costs and lost financial support. Camp is financed by camper fees, community donations, fund raising, and grants.
- ☺ **Camp registration fee is \$75 before June 18th/\$85 June 19th-July 9th. This fee DOES NOT include a t-shirt. We can only accommodate 120 kids. Registration is subject to space available. Scholarships available for early registration.**
- ☺ Counselors are hired teens and workshop leaders are community volunteers.
- ☺ Workshops vary from year to year but often include painting, archery, geocaching, drama, hiking, cooking, stilt walking, science projects, bookmaking, sports, braiding, and sculpting.

If requesting a scholarship, include how much you can contribute, reasons for request, and if you will be able to volunteer at camp. **Remember: early deadline is 6/26~final deadline is 7/9. Late fee not covered by scholarship. We can only admit 120 kids, please get registration in ASAP. Absolutely NO registration after 7/9.**
